



Children under the age of 12 must be supervised by a parent/carer over 18 years old.

Supervision requires that the children must remain in the company of the responsible adult at all times, whilst in the show pavilion.

The Club is not a licensed child-minding facility and club members can not take responsibility for the supervision of children within the show pavilion at any time.

Common sense should be used at all times, parents/carers are responsible for setting boundaries for their child's behavior in consideration of the comfort, enjoyment and safety of all club members, visitors and animals.

It is the responsibility of the parent/carer to ensure the welfare of their children.

Children must be accompanied by a parent/carer to use the toilet facility.

Children must not enter the Kitchen area.

Please ensure all children do not approach the judge's bench, stewarding area or other club members tables without the supervision of a parent/carer.

Please note unattended/unruly children in a show pavilion may be at risk of:

- Leaving the premises
- Hurting themselves
- Becoming bored & disruptive to other club members/visitors
- Become distressed/sick
- Put an animal's welfare in jeopardy
- Being approached by a stranger

Parent/Carers who do not supervise their child appropriately whilst in the show pavilion may be exposing their child to potential harm.

As such if a child is behaving in a manner which is potentially unsafe and disruptive to club members/visitors/animals or damaging of club property as determined by the club committee the parent/carer will be notified. If the behavior continues then the committee reserve the right to ask the parent/carer to leave the show pavilion for the remainder of the day.

This policy has been written to ensure the safety and comfort of children/club members/visitors/animals and everybody's enjoyment of our club shows.
